Hawkeye Whitetail

Most of you know our credentials for upland hunting date back 70 years. However, in the last few years, we have been hard at work to increase the quality of whitetail hunting offerings for our guests as well.

4 seasons ago we began a new whitetail management program focused on habitat management, food plots, protein feed and mineral supplementation. This is quite a challenge, especially on a low-fence operation; however, the characteristics of the Piney Woods allow for unique opportunities to create substantial holding habitat. Although the area is not known for its large bucks, I think you will agree we have made progress!

Early Season Bird Hunting – Can Be Spicy.

October in the Piney Woods can feel like summer, but we are ready to start the wingshooting season off with a bang! Early season hunters at Hawkeye will see very pleasant morning weather on their hunts. However, as the day wears on and afternoon hunts begin, we must remind our guests to take care and stay hydrated. Our guides will remind guests to bring light weight field wear, stop often to provide water for guests and dogs alike, and we will be cycling dogs out frequently to maintain a quality hunt and prevent heat injury.



BY THE NUMBERS:

Hawkeye Deer Hunts

01

Deer hunts are available for all overnight guests at Hawkeye during our extended MLD season.

02

Upland hunting guests may also request to hunt deer during their stay at Hawkeye.

03

Guests may harvest 2 deer per stay. One of those may be a buck or both can be doe.

04

We will take care of the field dressing, meat prep for processing, and arrange for taxidermy.
